The European School Copenhagen welcomed its first students in August 2014 and has been growing year on year. The school will have nearly 1,000 students when it is fully phased in. The first European Baccalaureate students are expected to graduate in the summer of 2022. In autumn 2018, the school will reach another important milestone, when the doors open to the school's brand new campus in the heart of the Carlsberg City District. The school will be located in close proximity to the historic Carlsberg Elephant Gate and other important Danish landmarks. NEW SCHOOL BUILDING

PARTNERS

The new school building is being constructed by BAM Denmark in cooperation with Vilhelm Lauritzen Architects and NORD Architects, along with the consulting engineers EKJ. The developer is Carlsberg Byen P/S and the project is financed by the City of Copenhagen, Realdania, Novo Nordisk Foundation, Nordea-fonden and the Danish Industry Foundation.

ADMISSION

The European School Copenhagen is a publicly funded international school under the Municipality of Copenhagen, which means that education at the school is free of charge. Admission to the school is based on a set of criteria set by the Municipality of Copenhagen and a language screening. The school primarily admits pupils to the new nursery classes starting each school year, but also admits pupils in the established primary and secondary classes when spaces are available.
