COMMERCIAL FISHING

Port of Skagen is Denmark's leading fishing hub, handling the largest volume and value of fish in the country. With deep-water access (up to 13 meters) and world-class facilities, the port is a key center for pelagic and demersal fishing.

Pelagic Fishing – A Full-Service Hub

As Denmark's largest port for pelagic fishing, Skagen offers a complete value chain from landing to export. The port's deep-water quays accommodate the largest trawlers, and on-site services include trawl repair, vessel maintenance, and advanced logistics. Recent investments in shore power infrastructure allow vessels to reduce emissions by shutting down their generators while in port.

Demersal Fishing – Optimized for Growth

To meet rising demand, Skagen has expanded its fish terminal, increasing water depth from 5 to 7 meters for improved handling. The EU-approved border control point streamlines international trade, while modern facilities ensure efficient processing, sorting, and distribution.
